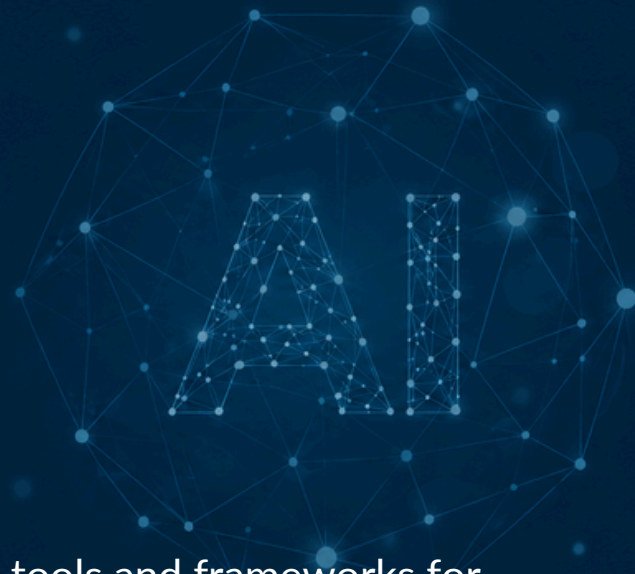


# Tools for Good Governance in the AI Era
